

The National Infantry Museum is well designed for self-guided tours. This brochure will help you plan your visit, whether you intend to see every gallery or just portions of the museum.

Trained volunteers are stationed throughout the museum to direct you, answer your questions, and enhance your experience.

### **Fife and Drum**

Enjoy sandwiches, soups, salads and much more in a casual atmosphere at the Fife and Drum restaurant and bar on the museum's mezzanine level.

### **Giant Screen Theater**

The Giant Screen Theater presents larger-than-life movies, documentaries and stage presentations. Show schedules and ticket prices are posted at the Tickets counter. Looking for a snack? Enjoy popcorn, candy, hot dogs, nachos, ice cream and more at the Concessions stand!

### **Down Range**

This is where the action is! Try your hand at firing weapons in a training simulator just like the Soldiers use, or embark on a virtual rescue mission in a real Humvee!

### **Soldier Store**

Don't forget to pick up a souvenir in the Soldier Store, operated by the famous military supply company, Ranger Joe's. The Soldier Store is located near the museum's entrance and is open during regular museum hours.

### **The Campus**

Heritage Walk, lined with state and territorial flags and commemorative pavers, leads from the museum to Inouye Field, where graduation ceremonies are held for Army trainees. Alongside it, a 3/4-scale replica of the Vietnam Wall lists the names of more than 58,000 killed or missing service members. Just beyond the parade field is the Memorial Walk of Honor, a park-like setting with dozens of memorials to Infantry units. World War II Company Street features seven buildings outfitted with period pieces depicting life on an Army post during the 1940s. Check the information desk for tour times.

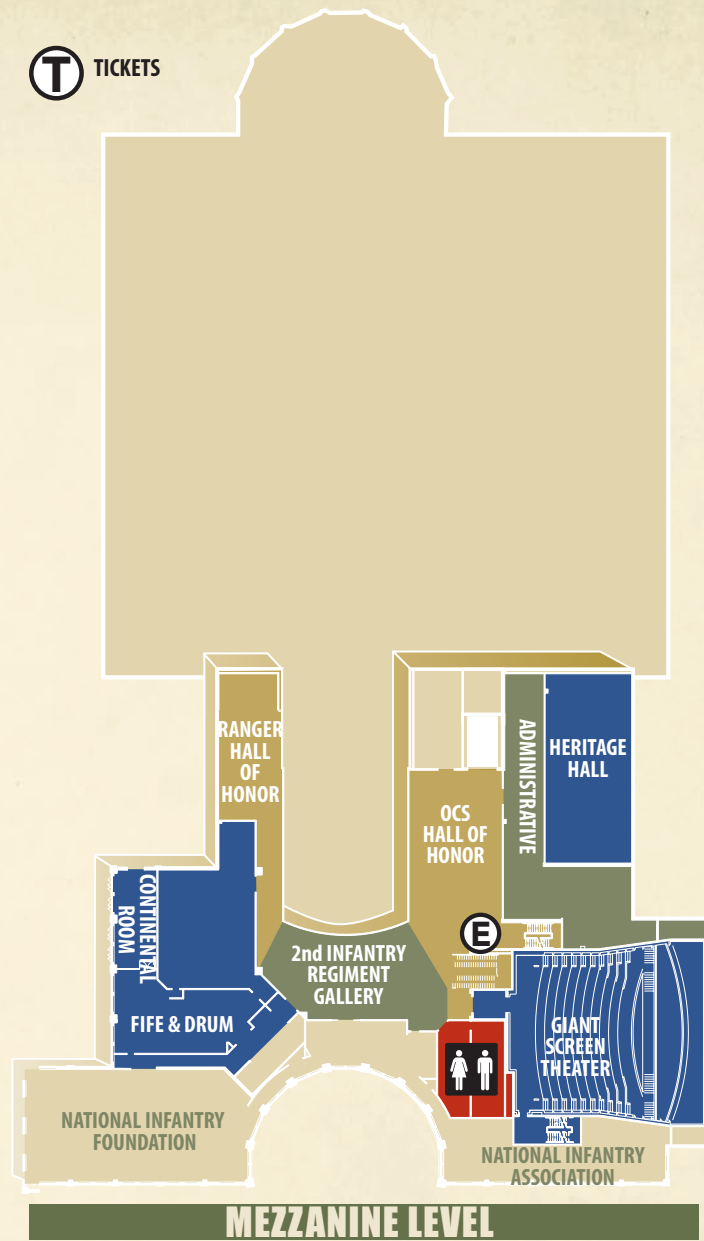
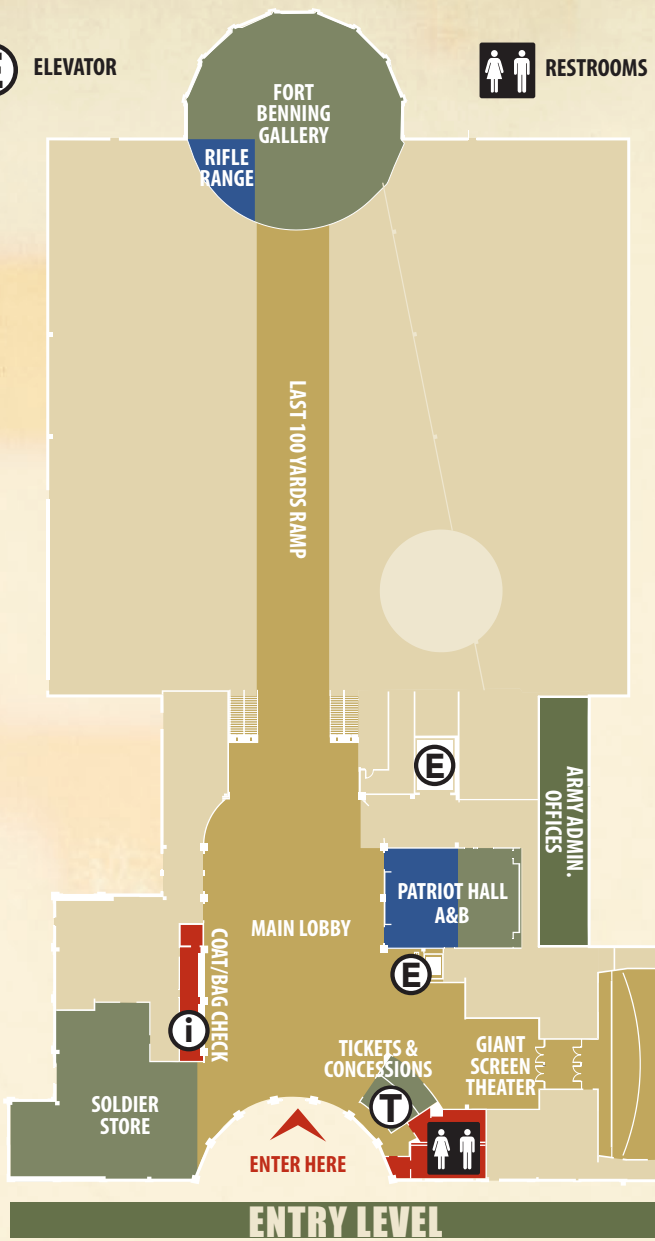
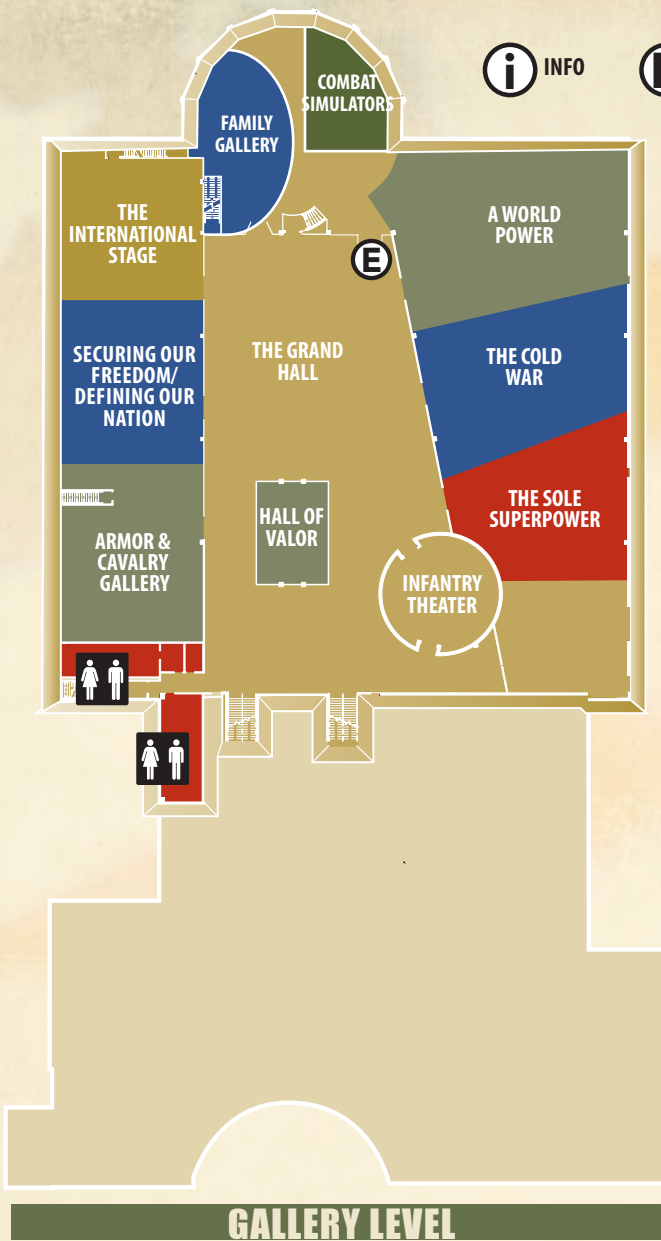

## Visitor Information

There is no admission fee; however, a \$5 per person donation is requested at the door.

Parking is free. Shuttles are available during graduations and special events for visitors with limited mobility.

The museum is accessible to people with disabilities. Wheelchairs are available at the information desk.

### MUSEUM HOURS:

9am-5pm Tuesday through Saturday

11am-5pm Sunday

The museum is closed on Mondays except on federal holidays.

*Weapons, pets (other than service animals), and purses or bags larger than 11"x15" are not permitted inside the museum.*

Photos and videos may be taken for personal use; however, no flash photography is allowed inside the museum.

The museum is a smoke-free facility.

Food and drinks are not allowed beyond the museum's lobby.
